The admission season for Pine Forge Academy will begin late this month. Pine Forge Academy's 2015-2016 enrollment goal is 165 students.

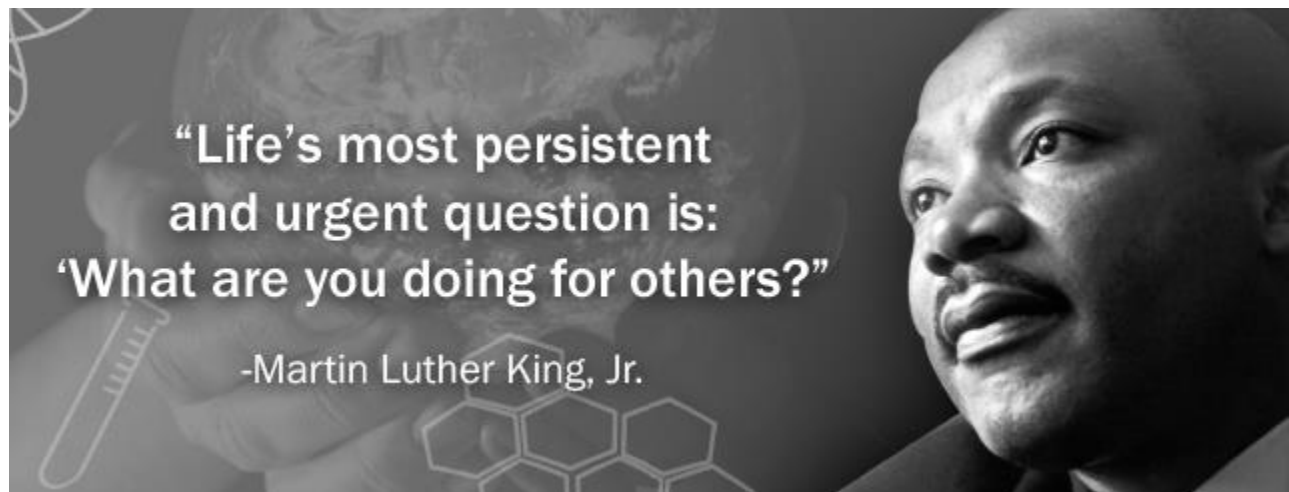
How can you help?
