Each contestant chooses the topic of his/her speech. The purpose of the speech is to set forth a position while applying the principles of the 4-Way Test. The issue to be addressed should be something from the speaker's personal experience or general knowledge. There are no restrictions regarding the choice of topic as long as it is not blatantly offensive. If a

contestant or coach is in doubt about the appropriateness of a topic, he or she should check with the District Contest Chair. The decision of the Contest Chair will be final.

The 4-Way Test of the things we think, say, or do:

1. Is it the TRUTH?
2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
