WILLIAM O. Sr. and IDA M. ANDERSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Benefactors: The Anderson Family

In Memory of: Our parents' investment in Pine Forge Academy Christian education.

Criteria: Restricted to applicants from a Single Parent Household who 1) are entering either the 11th (Junior) or the 12th (Senior) grade; 2) can demonstrate that he or she consistently supports and upholds the Christian principles expected of all students at Pine Forge Academy; 3) consistently demonstrates and manifests a Christ-centered influence on the campus, as recognized by faculty, staff, peers, and the community at large; 4) maintains an overall 3.0 (GPA) or higher; and 5) demonstrates financial need.

The Anderson Family scholarship recipients are students who clearly demonstrate their desire and ability to overcome barriers in order to achieve their goals. Applicants must be full-time students at Pine Forge Academy in the academic year for which the scholarship is awarded.

Up to \$12,000.00 annually. At least two Awards up to \$6,000.00 each, but not more than \$3,000.00 will be awarded each semester to any student.

Applicants are expected to submit a well-written, meaningful essay, not to exceed 500 words, that is illustrative of their desire and determination to succeed. Suggestions to include in your essay are as follows:

- 1) How will you achieve your future academic and career goals?
- 2) Why do you need financial assistance?
- 3) Discuss the extent of your campus involvement and contributions to the Pine Forge Academy community (e. g., events, organizations, and mentoring opportunities that helped you to learn and build essential life skills.)

Dr. Melodie Mayberry-Stewart Scholars Scholarship

Benefactor: Melodie Mayberry-Stewart

Criteria: Each applicant must be admitted as a full-time student entering the 10th (sophomore), 11th (junior), or the 12th (senior) grades. Each applicant must provide evidence of the following criteria: 1) Have an overall GPA of 3.5 or above; 2) Demonstrate exceptional academic achievement, and the potential for obtaining a college degree; 3) Each applicant must consistently practice positive Christian-centered leadership traits, which positively improves the student-life campus environment and the larger community; 4) Show leadership skills; and 4) Demonstrate financial need as verified by the Business Office.

One \$1,500.00 scholarship will be awarded annually.

Each applicant must submit an essay, between 300 and 500 words, that provides evidence of each of the required criteria and emphasizes their academic performance, campus and community involvement, and their leadership skills. While focusing upon these criteria, one or more of the following questions should be addressed in each applicant's essay:

- 1) How attending Pine Forge Academy has changed and impacted your spiritual, academic, and social experiences?
- 2) If you were the decision maker, what changes would you implement to improve the Pine Forge Academy experience for others and how do you plan to meaningfully support Pine Forge Academy in the future?
- 3) Discuss the extent of your current campus involvement and contributions to the Pine Forge Academy community, in one or more of the following rolls: active Pine Forge Academy church member, USM officer or participant, and/or as a class officer or contributor.
