Benefactors: The Anderson Family

In Memory of: Our parents' investment in Christian education at Pine Forge Academy.

Criteria: Restricted to applicants of/from a single parent household, entering either the 11th (Junior) or the 12th (Senior) grade the following academic year, who has demonstrated he/she consistently supports and upholds the Christian principles expected of students at Pine Forge Academy; consistently demonstrates and manifests a Christ-centered influence on the campus recognized by faculty, staff, peers, and the community at large; maintains an overall 3.0 (GPA) or higher; and demonstrates financial need. The Anderson Family Scholars are students who demonstrate their desire and ability to overcome barriers and to achieve their goals. Applicants must be full-time students at Pine Forge Academy for the academic year in which the Award is applied.

Submission and Deadline: Students must submit their essay to the Registrar by 5PM on January 7, 2019.

Award: Two student awards at \$6,000.00 each: \$3,000.00 to be awarded each semester.

Applicants are expected to submit a well-written, meaningful essay, not to exceed 500 words, expressing determination to succeed. Suggestions to include in your essay:

- 1) How do you plan to achieve your future goals?
- 2) Why do you need financial assistance?
- 3) Discuss the extent of your campus involvement and contributions to the Pine Forge Academy community (e.g., events, organizations, mentoring opportunities that help learn and build essential life skills, etc.).
